

News from the 2013 National NPM Convention

My daughter, Tammy, and I had the pleasure of attending the National NPM Convention in Washington, DC, July 29- Aug. 2. It was an exciting time as the speakers reflected on the fifty years that have passed since the renewal through Vatican II and the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy. While much time was spent on reflection and analysis of the changes, most of the Breakout Sessions dealt with the "nuts and bolts" of ministry. The convention was wonderful as it opened avenues to areas of music and liturgy both for clergy and laity alike. Some topics were as follows: technology, active participation, conducting, vocal production, psalms, prayer, chant, licensing, organ techniques, small ensembles, Sing to the Lord, sacraments, choirs, multicultural communities, planning, musical repertoire, Hispanic music, and the list goes on and on. You can download some of the handouts at www.npm.org . We had an opportunity to read through "tons" of new music from publishers and were fortunate that our luggage didn't go over the 50lb. limit. Tammy spent several hours judging cantors for certification. She is on a national cantor team and it was her idea to offer this service at convention. There were over 50 that signed up. I was involved with chapters as Dr. Robert Wolf from the Lansing, MI chapter and I are Co-Chairs for the National Committee for NPM Chapters. The turnout for our events was so encouraging. It's an exciting time to be working with chapters but challenging as well. The best part for me was the Eucharistic Celebration held at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception with Cardinal DiNardo presiding. To worship with music that is "over the top" in excellence and the congregation filled with singers who spontaneously burst into 4-part harmony is thrilling. The postlude was the icing on the cake as the choir sang Ralph Vaughan Williams, "Let All the World in Every Corner Sing" with orchestral accompaniment. It nearly brought me to my knees.

My regret was the fact that only Tammy and I were present from the Rapid City diocese. These gatherings are so fruitful. It is our prayer that more from our diocese will attend the next convention to be held in St. Louis from July 14-18, 2014. St. Louis is so much closer and I can guarantee that all the attendees will be showered with a volume information and inspiration. The theme of the convention will be Proclaim Good News. What could be better than that?

Tammy Schnittgrund Appointed National Administrator for the Intermediate Cantor Certificate

Tammy Schnittgrund, former Assistant Director of Recruitment for NPM's Rapid City chapter and local cantor trainer, was recently appointed national administrator for the "Intermediate Cantor Certificate" (ICC). Ms. Schnittgrund has been a member of the national Cantor Steering Committee since joining the committee in 2009 and helped write the ICC. In addition to her work on the committee Ms. Schnittgrund is an orchestra teacher in the Rapid City Public Schools as well as Director of Strings at South Dakota School of Mines and Technology.

The ICC recognizes the achievement of more developed skills expected of cantors. The test for this intermediate certificate has three components:

Singing and leading advanced service music – two responsorial psalms from suggested lists, a published *Gloria*, and an *Alleluia*.

Sight singing a hymn and a responsorial psalm.

A written test of musical and liturgical knowledge plus a short paper on the psalms.
