Officer Elections: As most of you know, we elect new officers at the Fall Meeting.

Would you like to serve on the board? Fill an open position? Let us know. Contact marycsnelson@gmail.com / 402-429-4924. Duties listed for Director and Programming Coordinator are those set out in the 2024 National NPM Chapter Manual. **Open positions are:**

- **Director** (elected position; two-year term, renewable one time)
 - > schedules and chairs the Board meetings, prepares the agenda, and oversees the preparation and distribution of minutes
 - ➤ guides the Board in setting the vision and goals, ensuring that the vision and goals complement those of the national organization
 - ➤ oversees the implementation of Board decisions
 - > maintains communication with the diocese
 - > serves as the primary liaison with the NPM National Office and the Membership Forum
 - ➤ makes every effort to attend the annual NPM Convention, including all events programmed for Chapter leadership
 - ➤ is a co-signer on the Chapter bank account
 - ➤ assures the Chapter is using tools provided by the National Office, including npm.org email addresses, online content, and Google Suite tools.
- Programming Coordinator (elected position)
 - ➤ coordinates Chapter events by contacting the venue to secure the date, specific facility, and other needs expected of the hosting venue
 - > contacts speakers, clinicians, and other participants to secure their participation
 - ➤ manages logistics during the event itself
- **Hospitality Coordinator** (appointed position). Sole duty: line up someone to bring morning snacks to each quarterly meeting. It's a small thing, but if you find you're willing to take it on, it will lighten the load for the rest of us on the board.
- **Member at Large** (appointed position). Attends the board meetings and pitches in where needed. Many hands make light work, and your ideas and suggestions could help make ours a better chapter.

Criteria: Nominee need not meet all criteria:

- 1. NPM national member (preferred).
- 2. Recognized role in West River music ministry (i.e. director, organist, pianist, pastor, cantor, choir member) for 5 years or more.
- 3. Specific exceptional contribution(s) that enliven music liturgy and aid in developing liturgical resources.
- 4. Example(s) of providing support to parish musicians, clergy and other worship leaders as the nominee fosters the art of liturgical music involvement.

☐ Peggy Langenfeld Memorial: Recognizes one person or organization who has promoted NPM and chapter activities in an extraordinary way.

Criteria: Nominee need not meet all criteria:

- 1. NPM national member (preferred).
- 2. Promotion of NPM at parish and diocesan level.
- 3. Participation in one or more meeting programs.
- 4. Current or past officer in Rapid City NPM Chapter.
- ☐ Emerging Music Minister Award: Recognizes an adult or youth who shows promise as a musician contributing to Catholic music liturgy.

Criteria:

- 1. Service of five or fewer years (consider length and breadth, participation in other ministries).
- 2. Commitment (i.e. consistent involvement).
- 3. Demonstration of continued learning in music liturgy.
- 4. Demonstration of initiative.

Age Categories:

- 1. Emerging Adult: Person 24 years or older.
- 2. Emerging Youth: Person 16 23 years old.
- ☐ Service Year Awards: Recognizes a person who has contributed their time and music talents to church music for a number of years (or slightly more).

Year categories: 5, 10, 25, 40, 50, 60, 70, and 75 years.
