Cantoring: Tammy Schnittgrund, St. Therese, Rapid City

Tammy served for a number of years on NPM's national Committee for Cantors, and later as Chair for this committee. She helped craft the rubrics for NPM's Cantor Certification program, and has led multiple cantor workshops in our diocese, helping dozens of cantors in our diocesan parishes earn their certification.

In this capacity, she has worked directly with pre-eminent leaders of Cantor education across the country, including Sr. Kathleen Harmon, who wrote the 'goto' guide for Cantors in Catholic liturgy, "The Ministry of Cantors."

Tammy has been a music educator in the Rapid City School District for over twenty-five years. Her current roles include Strings Coordinator for all orchestral programs in the district, Conductor of Rapid City Stevens High School orchestra, and Orchestral Director at the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology.

Tammy earned her undergraduate degree in music education at Northern State University, and her masters degree at University of Montana.
